Established in 1874 by Alphonso Johnson, a graduate and former teacher at the NY Institution for the Deaf. The school is now run by the NYSED and currently serves children in 42 counties in Central NY. NYSSD has programs for elementary, high school, college prep, daily living skills, vocational education and fine arts along with a deaf infant program.
