## Criteria of the Pi State Achievement Award

The Pi *State Achievement Award* is presented annually to a DKG NYSO member who has made outstanding contributions to the Society at the State Level.

A DKG NYSO member may nominate a member for the Achievement Award. The nomination must be approved by the nominee's Past, Current, Co-Chair, Chapter President or Vice- President and supported by three letters of recommendation from members who have worked with the nominee. A nominee must have a minimum of five years of active membership in good standing. No person may receive the Achievement Award more than once.

If a nominee is not selected to receive the Achievement Award the first year she is nominated, her application is held for consideration a second year. At that time additional information may be added to her nomination application. A State President is ineligible for the Achievement Award during her time in office.

The deadline for nominations is February 15<sup>th</sup>.

## Goals of the Pi State Achievement Award Committee

- 1. To encourage NYSO Chapter Presidents/and members to nominate candidates for the Pi State Achievement Award.
- 2. To select a deserving nominee for the Pi State Achievement Award.
- 3. To present the award, a small gold pin in the form of a Tudor rose, to the recipient at the DKG NYSO Executive Board Meeting/Spring Seminar or Convention.
- 4. To annually publicize the name of the Pi State Achievement Award winner in *Pi Lights* and on the DKG NYSO Website.
