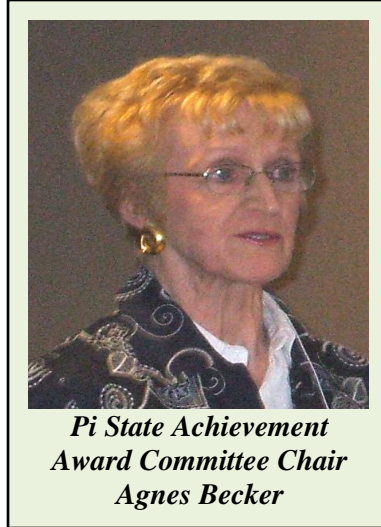

About the Pi State Achievement Award Committee

The *Pi State Achievement Award* is presented annually to a Delta Kappa Gamma member(s) who has made outstanding contributions to the society at the State level.

A DKG member may nominate a member for the Achievement Award. The nomination must be approved by the nominee's Chapter President and supported by three letters of recommendation from members who have worked with the nominee. A nominee must have a minimum of five years of active membership in good standing. No person may receive the Achievement Award more than once.

If a nominee is not selected to receive the Achievement Award the first year she is nominated, her application is held for consideration a second year. At that time additional information may be added to her nomination. A State President is ineligible for the Achievement Award during her time in office.

The deadline for nominations is February 15th.

Goals of the Pi State Achievement Awards Committee

1. To encourage Pi State members to nominate candidates for the Pi State Achievement Award
2. To select a deserving nominee for the Pi State Achievement Award
3. To present the award, a small gold pin in the form of a Tudor rose, to the recipient at the Spring Convention/Seminar
4. To annually publicize the name of the Pi State Achievement Award winner in *Pi Lights* and on the State website
