- * It is advisable to keep a file of your Chapter's <u>Photo Release</u>
 <u>Forms</u>, a signed/dated consent to publish a person's photo. Sisters may withdraw consent at any time after signing.

- * Photos may also be used for Pi State's electronic scrapbook, archive and presentations.
- * Depending on publication restrictions, usually space, some photos may need to be omitted.
