The scholarship may not exceed \$1000, and the recipient is responsible for providing receipts for all expenses. Receipts for expenses to be covered must be submitted to the Foundation treasurer within 60 days from the completion of the experience for which the scholarship is granted. Allowable expenses will include tuition, registration, books and materials, mileage and tolls. Housing and meals may be considered, depending on the funds available.
